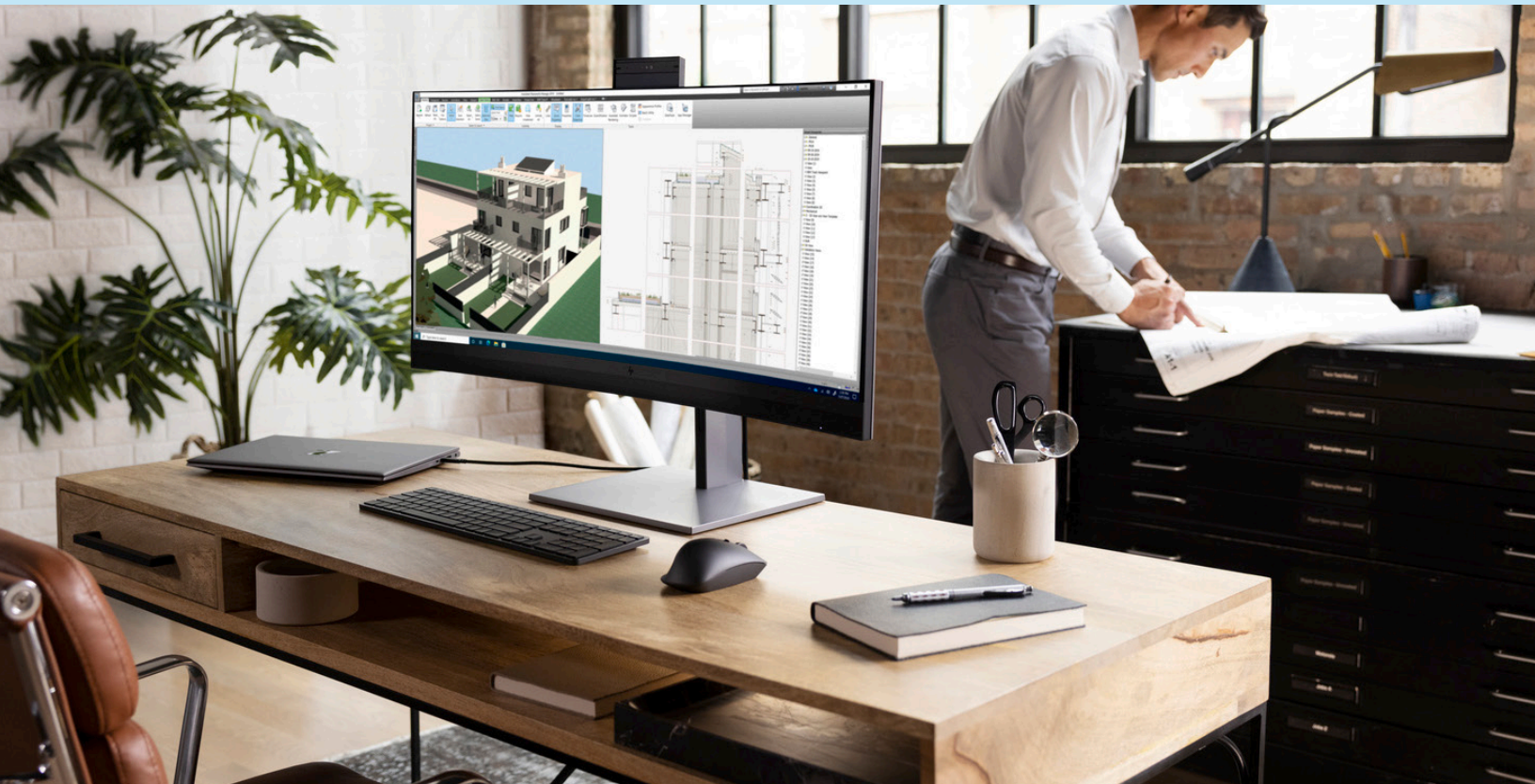


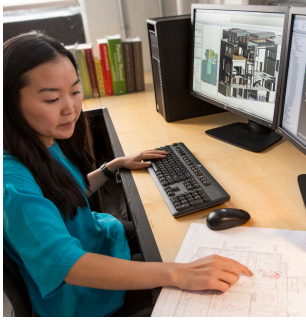


Secure AEC Data with NVIDIA Omniverse Enterprise and HP Anyware

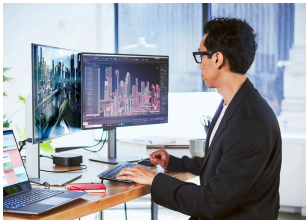


Secure, Real-Time Collaboration for Dispersed Teams

NVIDIA Omniverse Enterprise is a transformative virtual platform that offers end-to-end collaboration opportunities and real-time true-to-reality simulation.¹ It enables teams to collaborate from different AEC applications in real time on the same design project, transforming complex design workflows for organizations of any scale.

One of the major benefits NVIDIA Omniverse Enterprise offers AEC firms is that it centralizes digital assets. Omniverse Enterprise Nucleus Server is deployed in the data center to connect teams to the same Omniverse environment, virtualized with NVIDIA RTX Virtual Workstation software.

Intellectual property stays safe in the digital workspace as files don't need to be downloaded to an individual's workspace and uploaded again once changes have been made. Omniverse seamlessly syncs file changes between creative tools, preserving the integrity of files throughout the pipeline and maintaining a single source of truth, a common frustration many AEC organizations deal with today.



Work securely from virtually anywhere

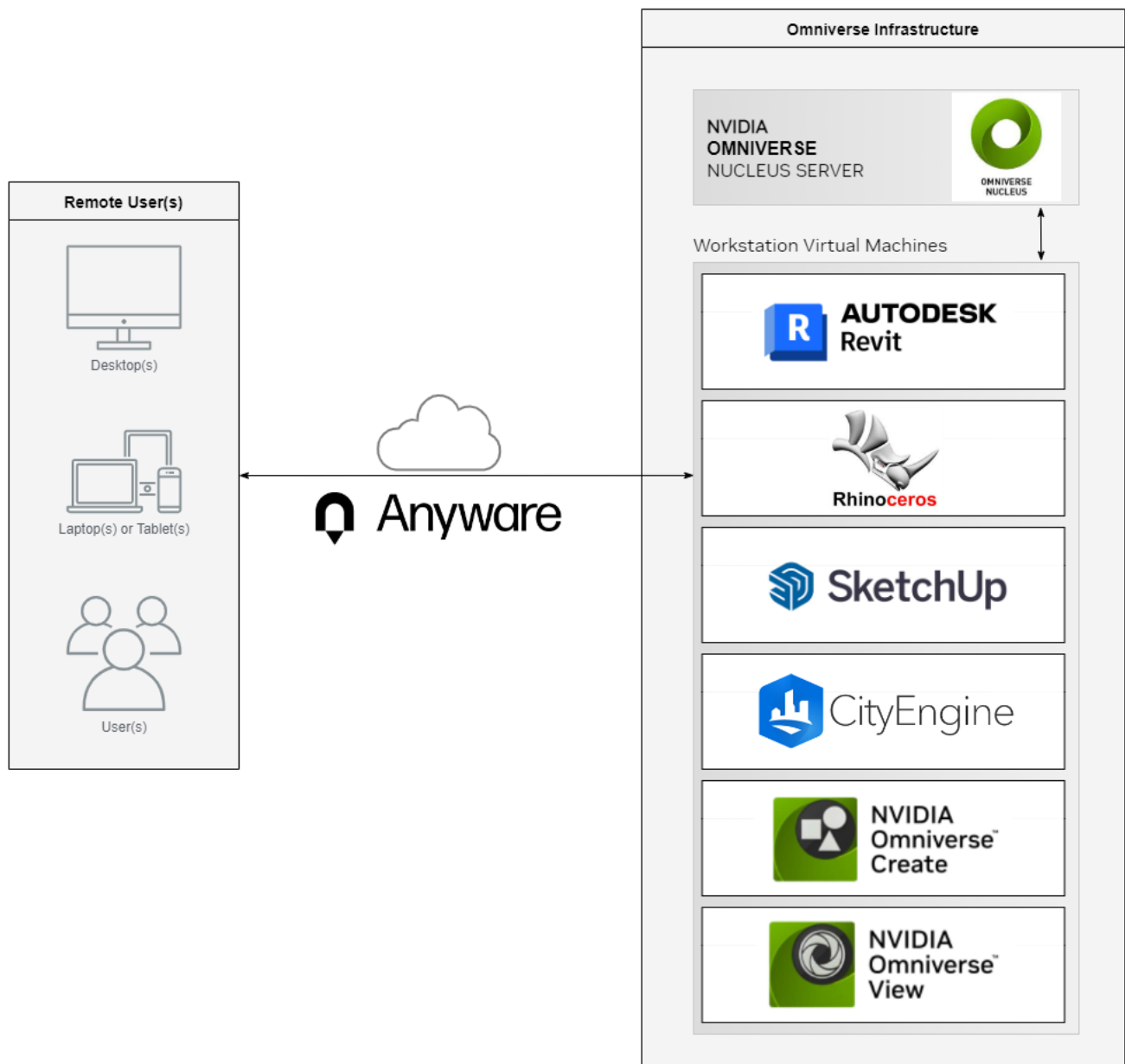
When AEC users access NVIDIA Omniverse via HP Anyware², they do so in a secured manner. HP Anyware is the enterprise software that streams highly interactive desktop displays between virtually any host and end-user device using PCoIP technology.

No AEC project data ever leaves the data center, nor is it transferred from workstation host to a remote user because Anyware only transmits display information in the form of encrypted pixels over the network. Sensitive data stays centralized and securely protected in the data center through AES 256 encryption.

Anyware offers secured access to digital workspaces without a VPN so AEC teams can work from virtually anywhere without worrying about opening their IP to cybersecurity threats. Additionally, HP Anyware includes Anyware Manager to easily provision and monitor PCoIP connections and manage user-access to shared digital workspaces with multi-factor authentication.

Enterprise data and software are safely secured inside central systems, so no one can tamper with your data or infiltrate your applications by compromising your remote endpoint devices.
